

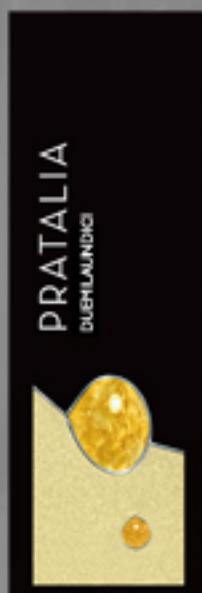


PRATALIA 2011

PRODUCING VINEYARDS one hectare
PLACE Capalbio, Maremma Tuscany, Italy
ALTITUDINE 100 mt. above sea level
TOPOGRAPHY hilly, just in front of the Tirrenian sea
SOIL clay and sand, mineral component inside
CLIMATE very mild winters, hot and breezy summers
EXPOSURE west
GROWING SYSTEM spurred cordons
DENSITY PER HECTARE 5000 plants
YIELD PER HECTARE 80 quintals
GRAPES 100% vermentino

Grape harvest at dawn, transfer to the winery at 3°, must sedimentation for 48 h at 8°, fermentation in refrigerated stainless steel vats.

Bright straw yellow. A striking, fruity bouquet, with clear hints of grapefruit and apple as well as acacia blossoms and aromatic spices. Its taste is highly fragrant, enhanced by the freshness and tartness of a long and pleasant aftertaste of almonds. It pairs wonderfully with fish, fried food and vegetables.
